Etymology. Construction is a general term meaning the art and science to form objects, systems, or organizations, and comes from Latin constructio (from com-"together" and struere "to pile up") and Old French construction. To construct is the verb: the act of building, and the noun construction: how a building was built, the nature of its structure.
