

Download Dice Roll And Tally Game

Dice-Roll and Tally Game 2. A variation to this game is to use the sheet with rows of boxes with numbers 1-6. The child rolls the dice and makes a tally in the first box next to the number rolled. Continue in this manner making one set of tally marks in each box llll . The game ends when all six boxes have tally marks next to one of the numbers. The root of this dice math activity is simple: roll and tally. But trust me – this activity is so much more than just rolling and tallying. I set this activity up for my 4 year old. And it was the perfect level for him. His three year old sister hung around to help and watch – and did learn a lot from it too – but just couldn't quite be ... The goal of the game is simple. When the “penny pot” is empty, be the player with more coins. Roll the die. Collect the number of pennies from the “penny pot” that matches the number rolled on the die. Continue taking turns with your partner until there are no more coins in the penny pot. You must roll the exact number. Roll Dice, Write, and Tally the Numbers You can do this as a whole-class activity (one die for the whole class and everyone fills out their own page) or individually (if you've got enough dice). To be extra challenging, consider asking your students to provide totals for each column (they should have the same total in each column, but it may take students a little time to catch that).
